
Welcome!







Once you sign up, you will get a confirmation email, check your email and click the link. Be aware, that Sustainbase does not use passwords - you will get an email every time you log in.


Once you are logged in, you should see this page:



If you were already signed in, you may be redirected automatically to the challenge page. If so, great! Otherwise, use the image below to get to the course:




After clicking on USWC Online Program you should see this:



The stuff on the right is made by Sustainbase - you won't be using it for our course. Instead, click on "Challenge Info" on the top left as shown in the image.

There you should this:



Click the orange "open case" button. Once you open the case, you should see all our videos, assignments, and transcriptions. The first video gives you a log in for a separate platform. Complete their guides and then fill out the template provided on our platform, just under the video. Watch the remaining videos and complete the assignments. If it is not specified how a document should be saved or done, you are free to choose how you complete it.

The last two video explain video pitching. Please upload a video to YouTube or other video hosting site and include a link to your video in your final hand in.

Finally, **your hand-in is due July 20th**, to do this, log in, get to the case page, and click "upload solution"
